To apply for a new I-20 form in the cases listed below, you must demonstrate sufficient financial support:

- * You are asking for your first I-20 from UNTHSC or for an extension of your stay.
- * There is a change in your funding.
- * You are asking for documents for the first time for your immediate family members.
- * The financial documents in your file are more than 12 months old.
