

Academic Program Assessment Review Team Overview

Purpose

The Academic Program Assessment Review Team (APART) conducts periodic and regular reviews of academic program assessment plans and results and reports its findings to the programs and the Provost.

Composition

The [APART](#) consists of eight members with overlapping three-year terms. Each UNTHSC dean appoints one faculty/staff member from his/her school to the team and the Provost appoints three UNTHSC faculty/staff members to the team. Staff members from the Office of Organizational Excellence provide support and are ex-officio team members.

Process

- The APART uses a rubric to evaluate assessment plans and results. All team members review each of the programs on an annual basis.
- The APART Team Leader assigns a primary and secondary reviewer for each program who lead the review for their assigned programs and prepare the consensus rubric.
- The APART Team Leader and OOE staff present the completed reviews to the respective deans and selected program faculty and staff.
- The APART reviews its process and makes improvements on a continuous basis.
