Policies of the University of North Texas Health Science Center Chapter 13 – Grants Management 13.120 Facilities and Administrative Costs Recovery and Distribution

Policy Statement.

To provide guidance concerning allocation of recovered facilities and administrative (F&A) costs, the capture and distribution of F&A costs and application of F&A rates.

The University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth applies the currently negotiated Federal Facilities and Administrative (F&A) rates to all federal, state and private funded grants, contracts and other agreements. In the event a sponsor limits or prohibits the full federal F&A recovery; the institution will recover the full amount allowable. Waivers for recovery of full F&A must be approved by the respective Dean or unit head; and by the Vice President for Research.

<u>Procedure / Duty</u> <u>Responsible Party</u>

1. F&A recovered monthly on grant accounts (projID's) will be credited to an institutional local F&A recovery account (deptID) on a monthly basis.

- 2. Funds to be returned to the appropriate Dean, Chair and Principal Investigator would be distributed from the institutional local F&A recovery account (deptID), on at least a semi-annual basis. Funds being returned to these individuals will only be distributed based on the following criteria:
- **OGCM**
- Active grant accounts, which recover UNTHSC "full federal" on-campus/off-campus rate

The rate of return will be as follows:

- 84% to the Institution
- 4% to the Dean or Unit Head
- 4% to the Chair or Department Head
- 8% to the Principal Investigator
