14.100 Policy on the Performance of Outside Clinical Practice Activity (Moonlighting)	

Policy Statement.

UNTHSC clinical providers with a clinical faculty appointment shall confine their professional activities related to the clinical practice of medicine to the activities endorsed or assigned by UNTHSC. The professional liability insurance coverage provided by UNTHSC serves as coverage for assigned professional activities performed for UNTHSC and will not cover professional activities performed outside of UNTHSC. Providers will not provide patient care services in any capacity of a professional or commercial nature to or for any person or firm, or engage in any other activity that is competitive with or adverse to the business of UNTHSC. Outside activities must be in accordance with UNTHSC Outside Employment policy 5.506 and the bylaws of UNT Health. In addition, all revenues generated by the provider for clinical services shall belong to UNTHSC.

Requests for exceptions to this policy shall be submitted in advance to the Department Chair for his/her review and approval. Requests approved by the Department Chair shall be forwarded to the President and CEO of UNT Health for final approval.

Application of Policy.

All UNTHSC Clinical Providers with a clinical faculty appointment.

Definitions.

1. Moonlighting – Clinical activity performed by a UNTHSC provider where UNTHSC does not do the billing
2. Professional Activities – Patient care delivery activities, any provision of patient care

Procedures and Responsibilities.

1. Ensure dissemination of moonlighting policy requirements to all clinical faculty.
Responsible Party: Department Chairs

2. Ensure compliance with moonlighting policy.
Responsible Party: Department Chairs, VP/Chief Medical Officer
