Why is it necessary?

The number of drug overdose deaths increased by nearly 5% from 2018 to 2019 and has quadrupled since 1999 (CDC, 2022). Over 70% of the 70,630 deaths in 2019 involved an opioid (CDC, 2022). In a number of instances, people who misuse medications, such as opioids, get their first dose from the home of other people who have been prescribed the drug, such as from the medicine cabinets of their parents, relatives, and friends. Removing prescription opioids from the home once they are no longer medically necessary is part of the solution to this crisis and can prevent accidental exposure or intentional misuse (Commissioner, 2022).
