Did You Know?

- When used properly, *less than 2%* of male condoms break.
- Women whose partners use condoms during intercourse *are at 30% less risk of infertility due to Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs).*
- When used correctly, latex condoms *reduce the risk of HIV and STIs* (Syphilis, Genital Herpes, Chlamydia) *transmission by 80%.*
- When worn in the vagina, *female condoms are comparable to male condoms* at preventing HIV, other STDs, and pregnancy.
