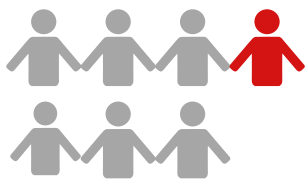

National HIV Testing Day



It's estimated that 1.1 million Americans have HIV. 1 in 7 (14%) of those people do not know they have it.

The CDC recommends that everyone between the ages of 13 and 64 get tested for HIV at least once as part of routine health care. Those with specific risk factors should get tested annually.
