Our comprehensive rape crisis and victim services program offers a continuum of care to survivors of sexual assault, sexual abuse and trauma.

Our **CRISIS HOTLINE** is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at **817.927.2737**. Victims and/or concerned loved ones can call to speak with a caring, supportive advocate.

IN PERSON CRISIS INTERVENTION & ADVOCACY SERVICES are available on a walk-in basis from 9 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday at our office, located at 1723 Hemphill.

Victim Advocates provide **RAPE EXAM SUPPORT** 24 hours a day, seven days a week during forensic rape exams at hospitals in Tarrant County.

Master-level therapists offer **INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP COUNSELING** for children and adults (both survivors and family members) who are victims of rape, sexual abuse, and other violent crimes such as abductions, assaults and survivors of homicide.

CASE MANAGERS help victims find resources for their immediate needs, such as transportation and housing referrals, and applying for Crime Victims' Compensation.

Highly qualified staff members and volunteers work closely with the Criminal Justice System to provide preparation for children and adults attending court proceedings, and accompanying any victim through a variety of criminal justice processes, including interviews, law enforcement procedures and trials.

Since 1983, more than 1.5 million children in North Texas have learned about personal safety from The Women's Center **PLAY IT SAFE!® PROGRAM**. The program uses age-appropriate materials to teach children Pre-K through high school how to reduce their risk of sexual and physical abuse by recognizing potentially abusive behavior, responding appropriately to threatening situations, and reporting abuse to a trusted adult. We provide extensive **TRAUMA-INFORMED TRAINING** in victimization issues—including the dynamics of sexual abuse and assault—to help teach school counselors, local law enforcement, criminal justice, medical personnel, case managers and other mental health providers how to best help victims.

Sexual assault and sexual abuse affects the entire community. We offer **ADULT EDUCATION PRESENTATIONS** to raise individual and community awareness about these issues and better promote safety. Topics offered to community organizations, parent groups, and college students include:
