**P**roject ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) is a collaborative model of medical education and care management that empowers clinicians in rural and underserved communities to provide specialty care to more people, right where they live.

### The HSC Geriatrics ECHO addresses patient care needs by:

- training community providers through HIPPA-compliant, technology-enabled collaborative learning
- addressing geriatric health concerns in the primary care setting
- conducting regular sessions with community providers to discuss specialized health care topics
- allowing case-based learning through patient case presentations by community providers to determine best treatment options

This case-based learning has shown to improve patient health outcomes and provider confidence in treating both common and complex conditions in their communities. There is no cost associated with participating, and the only requirements to join an ECHO session are access to a computer or mobile device with connection to the internet.

### What's involved?

Providers participate in ECHO sessions to develop advanced clinical skills and best practices in an 'All Teach; All Learn' environment.

Each one-hour session includes:

- 15-minute didactic presented by an ECHO Hub Team
- Case presentation presented by a community provider
