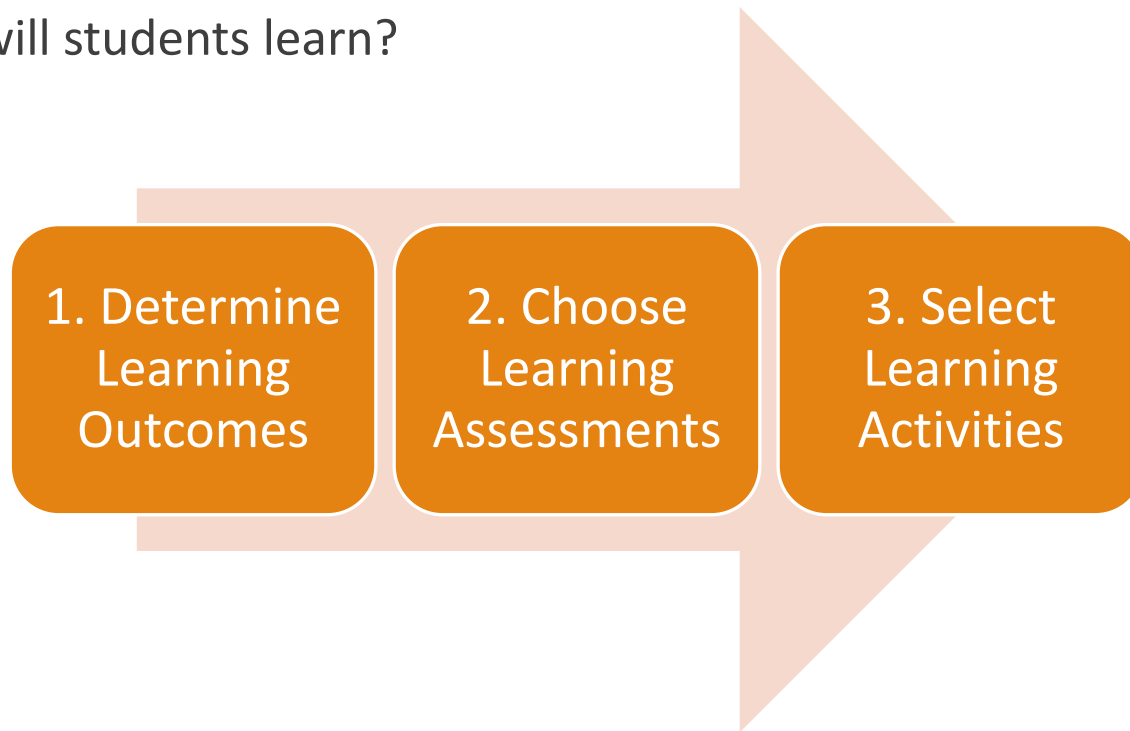
What is Course Design?

Differences from Traditional Methods

The traditional way of teaching...

- Starts with the textbook or content materials
- Choose teaching strategies
- Decide on assessment



Why Course Design?

- Provides structure
- Drives alignment
- Promotes student engagement

Shift your mindset

It will influence what to teach, how to teach, and how to assess.

Get to know your learner

There isn't a "one size fits all" approach

Rethink the learning objectives

Find ways to focus on what the students will be able to do

Shift the balance of power

It is an excellent way of requiring more learner responsibility.
