Faculty Development

All health professions now require integration of interprofessional education into their curricula. However, the majority of faculty were not exposed to interprofessional education and practice as a part of their own health professions training. Faculty are being called on to demonstrate innovative integration of interprofessional education and practice into the courses they teach. It is imperative that faculty are adequately equipped to provide interprofessional education. All faculty are encouraged to participate in earning a Certificate of Recognition in Interprofessional Education. Such training will demonstrate scholarship in the knowledge, attitudes and skills necessary to facilitate the integration of interprofessional education interprofessional education.

An **Interprofessional Education Faculty Certificate of Recognition** *and Certificate of* **Distinction** are available through the UNTHSC Center for Innovative Learning (CIL) in partnership with the UNTHSC Department of Interprofessional Education and Practice. Online and in-person learning formats will be utilized for this program.

IPE Certificate of Recognition Overview:

There will be six 1.5-hour interactive sessions held at UNTHSC from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm (lunch provided):

Pre-work for each in-person session will include approximately two hours of preparation via online learning modules. Faculty will demonstrate application of online learning through interprofessional team-based projects during the inperson sessions. Team-based projects will include teamwork simulations, an IPE escape room experience, an IMPROV IPE facilitation session, and an innovation session for integrating IPEP in curriculum and clinical experiences. Interprofessional faculty teams will work together outside of the in-person sessions to create an innovative IPEP public service announcement video.

IPE Distinction Overview:

An IPE Faculty Distinction will be offered to faculty who have completed the IPE Faculty Development Certificate of Recognition and partner with at least one other faculty member from a different profession to design, develop, implement and assess outcomes of an approved interprofessional learning experience with students or trainees of two or more professions. Faculty seeking the IPE Faculty Distinction will demonstrate additional scholarship by sharing the outcomes of their IPE at professional conferences or through publication of an educational research article.
