

PharmD/MPH Dual Degree



Program Overview

The MPH Public Health Leadership program is 42 credit hours with the potential to apply 6-12 PharmD credit hours, pending faculty review and approval. Courses are delivered online, allowing students to complete coursework any time of day. Experiential learning hours may also be eligible for application to both programs in certain circumstances.

Completion time will vary based on the degree plan and enrollment pace. The majority of students complete the MPH program concurrently during their four years in the PharmD program. The MPH completion requirement is six years.

Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent from a fully accredited institution
- Admission/enrollment in the HSC College of Pharmacy PharmD program
- An account and application in SOPHAS Express online application portal
- PCAT, MCAT, DAT or GRE *

- Statement of Purpose
- Resume
- 1 Letter of Recommendation
