Background and Special Features

Walmart Community Residency Program provides the opportunity to develop future pharmacy leaders with expertise. This program will focus on the advancement of pharmacy programs and services that measurably improve clinical outcomes and/or patient safety. This may include the implementation and study of the effectiveness of medication therapy management, patient adherence, disease state management, and health and wellness services. The residency also provides the opportunity to gain experience in teaching and earn a teaching certificate.

Program Overview

This unique residency program will immerse the resident in centralized medication therapy management services while providing opportunities in:

- creating, implementing, and evaluating programs to improve patient care;
- enhancing educational skills through didactic and experiential training;
- communicating and promoting services to various health care providers and educating patients regarding disease prevention and treatment;
- gaining skills in the management of a non-traditional pharmacy operation; and
- promoting professional development through local and national meetings, participation in pharmacy organizations, and building relationships.

Eligibility

Applicants must be graduates of an ACPE-accredited Doctor of Pharmacy degree program, be licensed in the state of Texas within 60 days of the program start date, and submit all application materials to Dr. Michelle Ndiulor, Residency Program Director at michelle.ndiulor@unthsc.edu NLT March 17, 2022.
