Spring Start Online (Part-Time)

The Master of Public Health in Public Health Leadership (42 credit hours) is an interdisciplinary degree that provides education and training for students who wish to continue their healthcare career and complete a public health degree while employed. This degree option is limited to the following applicants:

- 1) dual-degree students currently enrolled in a master's or doctoral program other than an MPH;
- 2) holders of an advanced degree, e.g., PhD, DO, MD, JD, DVM, MSN, MBA, PA; PharmD; or
- 3) persons with three or more years of substantive, professional experience in a health field.

Students gain foundational knowledge and skills in public health management, organizational leadership, health policy, program planning and evaluation, and communication campaign creation. Program graduates will contribute to the expansion and enhancement of a competent public health workforce that is needed for advancing the health of populations locally and beyond.
