

Call for Nominations 2022 HSC Faculty Achievement Awards

2022 HSC Faculty Achievement Awards Nominations Now Being Accepted!

Deadline: Friday, February 25, 2022.

Award Criteria

The candidate must have demonstrated **exemplary** performance in at least **three** of the following **five** categories with quality in a minimum of two categories. The primary focus of the review will be over the past three years.

- Teaching to include classroom, clinical, online, mentoring students in research and/or internships, teaching patients, residents, graduate students and peers
- o Research/scholarship to include grants, publications, awards, etc.
- o Service to include professional, university, and community service
- o Clinical service to include patient care
- Leadership to include leadership/elected positions in professional organizations, editorships of peer-reviewed journals, chairing committees, task forces and lab teams, etc.

Nominee Eligibility Criteria:

- Nominee's primary appointment must be:
 - 50% or more at the UNTHSC (from any school/college program or combination thereof). Primary appointment is determined by school/college by which the nominee originates.
 - Have been appointed by January 30, 2019 (3 years prior to nomination packet due date for 2022)
- Cannot currently be a faculty member with an administrative appointment at leadership position (chair, co-chair, center director, institute director, associate dean, dean, for example) or with more than 40% administrative workload.
- Cannot be a current member of the HSC Faculty Awards Committee members
- Cannot have been a past awardee (school or overall) in the previous 3 years
- Cannot be a self-nomination

Nomination process:

- The nomination should include two components: Letter of Nomination and CV.
- Letter of Nomination: A detailed letter describing the nominee's accomplishments (max 1500 words).
- Letters may include an introduction of nominee and rationale for nomination.
- Please include examples of "Exemplary" and "Quality" performance over the past three years in the above-mentioned categories.

Selection Process:

- The Awards Committee members will select one (1) faculty from each school/college as a finalist.
- Of the five (5) finalists, one (1) faculty will be selected as the overall winner.

Award:

The overall HSC Faculty Achievement Award winner will receive a single, pre-tax cash award of \$10,000. The school level HSC Faculty Achievement Award winners, who are not the overall winner, will receive a pre-tax cash award of \$2,500.
