



## What is an E-Pass?

An E-Pass is an annual transit pass offered to students and employees at a discounted price. The Office of Sustainability subsidizes E-Passes to a lower price once a year with funds from the Sustainable Campus Fee as approved by the Sustainability Committee.

## What Passes Are Available?

Two passes are available:

**LOCAL:** Valid on Trinity Metro Buses (including DASH), TRE from T&P Station to Centerport, and TEXRail.

**SUBSIDIZED PRICE: \$200 (75% OFF REGULAR PRICE!)**

**REGIONAL:** Valid on all services in Tarrant, Dallas and Denton counties (including all rail services).

**SUBSIDIZED PRICE: \$500 (~75% OFF REGULAR PRICE!)**
