

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging at UNTHSC

To provide more services to team members as well as promote sustainability, we're testing a program to provide vehicle charging on campus.

A dual-port station was donated to the university and has been installed in Lot 19, across Bunting Avenue from the MET ([see campus map](#)). Two parking spots are reserved for cars while charging.

In addition, outlets are available in the faculty and east garages, where drivers will be able to plug in as well. Two spots are reserved for electric vehicles until 10am (you will not be required to move your car after charging in the garage spots).



EV Permit Required: Because providing electricity for your vehicle is an added service, you will be required to display an EV parking permit hang tag. Go to <https://orgsync.com/54258/forms/229607> to purchase a permit. Prices for the 2016-2017 fiscal year are as follows:

- SEMESTER PASS – Valid now to May 31, 2017 - **\$25**
- SUMMER PASS – Valid June 1 to August 31, 2017 - **\$20**
- ANNUAL PASS – Valid now to August 31, 2017 (save \$5 by purchasing annual pass) - **\$40**

Charge Station in Lot 19: In order to charge at the dual port station located in Lot 19, you need to be registered with the ChargePoint Software. Please follow the directions below:

1. Go to <http://www.chargepoint.com/join/> and click on EV Drivers. Then click "Join Now".



2. Go through the Sign Up procedure which will enable you to create an account for a ChargePoint Card. You will be required to put credit card information, and it will mention a \$25 deposit. However, your card will not be charged until you use a station that charges. If you only use the UNTHSC station, you will never be charged that deposit.
3. It takes approximately 3-5 business days to receive the ChargePoint card in the mail. If you need to charge before your card comes in, call the number on the station, and the customer service representative will activate the station so you can charge for the day.
4. When you receive the card, you can wave it in front of the screen at the charge station (it will beep), and you will be allowed to charge.
5. Two parking spaces are reserved for EV charging. Please move your car when it's charged so others can utilize the station.

NOTE: You can use the ChargePoint Mobile App to find stations, start charging, and track your usage. This can be used in place of the card. See the website for more details: <http://www.chargepoint.com/mobile/>

Outlets in Parking Garages: Five outlets which can be reached from at least 10 parking spaces using your own charge cable are available in the Faculty and East Garages. Availability is on a “first come, first serve” basis, yet two parking spots are reserved for electric vehicles until 10am. Please charge only one vehicle per outlet box as plugging in more than one vehicle could overload the power supply. Locations of the outlets are indicated by the red dots in the map below.
