Welcome & Minutes

- ➤ Because the December and February meeting minutes had not been approved, motions were made to do so. Motion was made by Dr. Myles Quiben to approve the December minutes, and it was seconded by Sallie Spotanski. They were accepted unanimously by the committee members present. Motion was made by Aurelio Rodriguez to approve the February minutes and was seconded by Victoria Kay. The minutes were accepted unanimously.

Announcements

- ➤ <u>Electric Vehicle Charge Station:</u> A car charging station was installed in Lot 2 the week of October 19. This charging station was donated to the school. There are future plans to install another station in the MET lot 19 lot in the summer of 2016. We are currently working to get the software working in order for people to use the stations.

There are 35 plots, and we are taking food scraps from Saint Emilion Restaurant and using them in the compost. The plots are owned by 30% students, 30% community and 40% staff and faculty.
- ➤ Campus Outreach (LEAP Program): A big thank you to Myriam Martinez-Banuelos for overseeing the program while Sandy was on leave. We have 8 labs participating and we will launch to program to all labs this fall. Labs will receive grants for participation.
