

Transit 101: How to Ride

Types of Passes:



Local Pass – The T Buses Only

Local Pass + Zone 1 – The T Buses & TRE Zone 1

Regional Pass – The T Buses, TRE, & DART

Fare:

- A 2 hour pass for the buses is \$1.75.
- Students qualify for reduced but must have ID made from the transit authority.
- Employees get 25% off monthly and annual passes.
- Subsidized annual passes are sold in the fall each year for 80% off.

Route Information:

Route maps and schedules can be found at www.FWTA.org. Each bus has a route name/number along with popular destinations.

Reading the Schedules: Find the day of the week and use the map to determine the direction you want to travel based on your starting point. On the timetable grid, use the closest timepoint to determine the estimated arrival time of the bus (the NextBus App can give more accurate estimated arrival times). Note: Not all the stops are on map. Only the scheduled timepoints are listed.

Other Helpful Tips:

Remember to signal for the driver to stop by pulling or pushing on the yellow cord near the windows.

Helpful Tools:

GoPass: You can purchase passes using your smart phone on the GoPass App. You can purchase prior to using then activate when you get on.

NextBus: The buses are equipped with GPS, and this app gives you an estimated arrival time for buses at all the stops.

Google Maps: This app helps you to identify stops and you can use the transportation option to see routes to your destination.
