

#### Samaritan House

Samaritan House serves three meals a day to their residents living with HIV/Aids. Their kitchen crew cooks breakfast and lunch daily. However, they rely on volunteers to bring in dinner. **Dinner is served around 5:30 pm each night**. They currently have a few dates coming up that need to be filled:

- Thursday, August 1<sup>st</sup>
- Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Thursday, August 29<sup>th</sup>
- Saturday, August 31st

Volunteer groups can bring food that is prepared, or they can make the meal in our commercial kitchen. Meals can be anything you wish to share. Help save lives and prevent injury by participating in the Sound the Alarm, free smoke alarm installation event with the American Red Cross and local colleges/universities. Teams of 3 volunteers will install free smoke alarms in a local at-risk neighborhood. Volunteers will be organized into teams that will consist of 1 Smoke Alarm Installer, 1 Safety Ed-

ucator and 1 Document Recorder. Previous experience is not required, on-sight training will be provided. All community members are welcome to participate! Volunteers under 18 must have parental consent. A parental consent form is located on the registration page. The event will be held on Saturday, October 5th from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. 
