Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee

Title: IACUC Fees for Non-UNTHSC Principal Investigators

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A. PURPOSE/ SCOPE

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) Fee Schedule is developed to cover costs associated with IACUC review and staff activities for animal research projects for non-UNTHSC personnel, in which contracts or agreements do not include full Facilities and Administrative (F&A) (indirect costs) components.

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B. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. It is the responsibility of non-UNTHSC personnel to ensure they meet the qualifications to serve as a Principal Investigator for the study.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the non-UNTHSC personnel to pay any or all service fees related to the IACUC services associated with the specified research protocol and activity.

C. PROCEDURES

- 1. A non-affiliate researcher will need to receive eligibility to serve as a Principal Investigator at UNTHSC.
 - i. A written request will need to be submitted to the Institutional Official, with a copy of the Curriculum Vitae (CV) and a sponsor letter from a UNTHSC affiliate.
 - ii. The Institutional Official will provide written authorization to grant approval for Principal Investigator eligibility.
- 2. A non-affiliate researcher will need to have a contract verification for activity at UNTHSC, either via the Office of Contracts Administration or Office of Sponsored Programs. This agreement/ contract must be approved by the Institutional Official, and include appropriate funding for IACUC review, according to the IACUC Service Fees.

Fees for IACUC Services:

Initial Review (including triennial reviews):	\$3,000.00
Amendments (Full Committee Review):	\$1,500.00
Amendments (Designated Member Review):	\$ 750.00
Amendments (Administrative Review or VVC)	\$ 375.00
