#### 2. Completion of a program:

- **U.S. High School:**
  - Official transcript showing graduation from accredited U.S. high school or U.S. Department of Defense School overseas-attended for at least 3 years
  - **Send your SAT or ACT scores!**
- **U.S. Degree:**
  - Official transcript of U.S. Associate's, Bachelor's, Master' or Doctoral degree
- **High School/degree in English- speaking country:**
  - Graduation with a diploma/degree (High School--attended for a least 3 years or standard period of attendance as required by country, Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctoral degree) from an accredited school in a recognized English-speaking country listed below.
