### **Helpful Tips from the Grant Training Center for NIH Submissions**

- *Take time to read the funding announcement to understand what the institute is funding. If you are not sure, send the program officer an email.*
- *Be patient when emailing a program officer, it may take up to two weeks for a response.*
- *Cover letters are often not required, but it is a suggested document so that you may state your intentions and suggest reviewers as well as a study section.*
- *Study the roster of individual study sections.*
