


Clearing your insurance hold

Student Health Insurance Requirement

Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and School of Public Health

The health and welfare of the students at the Health Science Center is a high priority of the administration and faculty. All degree seeking students must have annual health insurance to be in compliance with Health Science Center policy. The choice of a specific insurance policy is the responsibility of the student. While the Health Science Center will not act as an agent between the student and the insurance company, information on specific policies is available in the Office of Student Affairs. The student is responsible for payment of all health care costs, including the premium, as determined by the specific health insurance plan chosen. Having chosen a plan, the student is responsible to follow the rules, regulations, and guidelines of their chosen plan.

All degree seeking domestic students enrolled at the University of North Texas Health Science Center who attend all or a portion of their curriculum on campus are required to have health insurance. Insurance coverage must meet the minimum standards as outlined by the federal government's Affordable Care Act. Degree seeking students enrolled in online ONLY curriculums are exempt from this requirement.

Degree seeking domestic students enrolled in the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and the School of Public Health are eligible to obtain school sponsored insurance on a voluntary basis. Enrollment and payment will be the sole responsibility of the student. Students enrolled in online-only programs who reside in Texas are eligible to enroll in the school sponsored plan. Online only students who do not reside in Texas are ineligible. *Eligibility may change based on insurance carrier requirements.

All registered International students, scholars, or other persons with a current passport and student visa engaged in educational activities at the University of North Texas Health Science Center campus are required to have health insurance. This includes International students engaged in curricular practical training, pre-completion Optional Practical Training, Internship, Practicum, Academic Training, Study Abroad, or other credit or non-credit activity as a bona fide University of North Texas Health Science Center student.



All international students are required to purchase the school sponsored plan, or provide documentation of the required coverage through the online waiver management system. Required coverage is defined as meeting the minimum standards as outlined by the federal government's Affordable Care Act plus any additional coverage required by the Office of International Student Services such as repatriation and medical evacuation through approved home government sponsorship or a U.S. employer policy.
