Applicants may have a degree in progress at the time of application, but must have a plan in place to have the degree conferred prior to the beginning of our courses in July.</p> <p>Applicants must achieve a minimum 3.0 GPA in the most recent 60 credit hours of coursework at the time of application.</p> <p>Applicants must achieve a minimum 3.0 GPA in our specifically required prerequisite coursework.</p> <p>Applicants must complete all of the prerequisite course requirements. Applicants may have coursework planned or in progress at the time of application, but must have a plan in place to have all coursework completed prior to the beginning of our courses in July.</p> <p>Applicants must submit letters of professional reference through PTCAS. A letter from a practicing PT is highly recommended. No recommendation letters will be accepted outside of PTCAS.
