Element 5.3:

A COM must publish and follow policies and procedures at all campus locations that effectively mitigate student, faculty, and staff exposure to infectious and environmental hazards, provide education on prevention of such exposures, and address procedures for care and treatment after such exposures.

A COM must publish and follow policies related to student, faculty, and staff mental health and wellness, and fatigue mitigation in the clinical learning environment.

Procedure Statement: The college shall work in cooperation with HSC to adopt policies that address the handling of infectious and biohazardous materials and seek to prevent the spread of infection at all locations operated by HSC. TCOM shall provide further guidelines for the safety of its students at remote sites. TCOM shall work in cooperation with HSC to adopt policies related to student, faculty, and staff mental health and wellness, and fatigue mitigation in the clinical learning environment.
