**Element 6.2:**

A COM and any branch campus must define and make all programmatic level educational objectives known to students, faculty, and others with responsibility for student education and assessment.

**Procedure Statement:** TCOM shall define programmatic level educational objectives that encompass the core osteopathic competencies.

<b>Procedure</b>	<b>Responsible Party</b>
1. TCOM shall develop and maintain programmatic level educational objectives that encompass the core osteopathic competencies of medical knowledge, patient care, communication, professionalism, practice-based learning, systems-based practice, and osteopathic principles and practice/osteopathic manipulative treatment. TCOM programmatic level educational objectives shall define the knowledge, skills, behaviors, and attitudes that osteopathic medical students are expected to demonstrate as evidence of their achievement prior to successful completion of the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.) degree.
