Element 7.2:
A COM must academically credential and/or approve the faculty at all COM and COM-affiliated and educational teaching sites.

Procedure Statement: TCOM will assure the academic qualifications of and provide academic appointments to all faculty providing teaching and assessment in its core curriculum.

Procedure		Responsible Party
1.	TCOM shall identify in its syllabi and curricular documents all faculty assigned teaching and evaluation responsibilities for all courses/clerkships.	TCOM Course Directors TCOM Clerkship Directors
2.	TCOM Academic Affairs shall create and maintain a roster of its assigned faculty providing learning experiences in all pre-clinical courses.	TCOM Academic Affairs
3.	TCOM Office of Osteopathic Clinical Education shall create and maintain a roster of its assigned faculty providing learning experiences at all affiliated teaching sites.	Office of Osteopathic Clinical Education
4.	TCOM and/or HSC shall have a mechanism to academically credential and/or approve the faculty at TCOM and TCOM affiliated sites.	Office of the Dean HSC Office of Faculty Affairs
