Element 8.1:

A COM must produce and publish a strategic plan for research and scholarly activities at all campus locations that documents how the COM intends to contribute to the advancement of knowledge through research and scholarly contributions. The plan must include cultural competency and health disparities research/scholarly activities.

Element 8.2:

A COM must have budgetary processes and a budget that supports research and scholarly activity by its faculty and students.

Element 8.3:

A COM must demonstrate how its research and/or scholarly activity includes and/or incorporates osteopathic manipulative medicine (OMM) and osteopathic principles and practice (OPP).

Procedure Statement: TCOM shall have a strategic plan for research and scholarly activities. The strategic plan shall document how TCOM intends to contribute to the advancement of knowledge through research and scholarly contributions in cultural competency, health disparities and osteopathic principles and practice. TCOM shall have budgetary processes and a budget that supports research and scholarly activity by its faculty and students.

2.	The Associate Dean for Research shall be responsible for providing strategic leadership, direction, and support for all activities related to faculty and student research in the Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine	TCOM Dean
3.	The Associate Dean for Research shall create and maintain a strategic plan for research and scholarly activities.	Associate Dean, Research
4.	The research and scholarly activity strategic plan shall be published on a public webpage.	Associate Dean, Research
5.	TCOM shall incorporate into its strategic plan tactical initiatives to encourage and support the conduct of research and scholarly production. Such initiatives shall include collaboration across the HSC and be in alignment with the mission of the college and the HSC. 6.	TCOM shall support research and/or scholarly activity focused on osteopathic manipulative medicine (OMM) and osteopathic principles and practice (OPP).	Associate Dean, Research
