<b>COCA Element 9.11 Health Insurance</b>	<b>Effective: July 2017</b> <b>Revised: October 2019, February 2024</b>

**Element 9.11:**

A COM must require that all students have health insurance.

A COM, or its parent institution, must offer a health insurance plan option to all students.

**Procedure Statement:** TCOM, in coordination with HSC, shall require all students to have health insurance. HSC shall offer a health insurance plan option for all students.

<b>Procedure</b>		<b>Responsible Party</b>
1.	All degree seeking students, except those enrolled in “online only” programs, must have annual health insurance to be in compliance with HSC policy.	HSC DSA
2.	HSC shall automatically enroll eligible students in the university Student Health Insurance policy with the option to opt out with verification of comparable coverage.	HSC DSA
