Element 9.9:

A COM must have policies and procedures to provide its students with access to diagnostic, preventive, and therapeutic health services accessible in all locations where students receive education from the COM.

Procedure Statement: TCOM shall provide access to physical health services that include access to diagnostic, preventive, and therapeutic health services accessible in all locations where students receive education.

Procedure		Responsible Party
1.	HSC shall secure the services of licensed health care providers and maintain clinic facilities that are dedicated solely for its enrolled students.	HSC Student Health Clinic
2.	No student presenting for urgent care or assessment will be turned away. HSC Student Health Clinic will work in cooperation with the HSC DSA to assure that the student health clinic is an approved provider for the university student health insurance plan.	HSC Student Health Clinic HSC DSA
3.	The HSC Medical Services Fee (\$54.5081) shall cover the cost of yearly TB Testing and Influenza vaccines.	HSC
4.	TCOM, in collaboration with HSC DSA, shall provide information to its students regarding physical health services during new student orientation and in the HSC catalog.	HSC DSA TCOM Medical Student Success
5.	TCOM shall provide students with physical health services information while on clinical clerkships.	TCOM Office of Osteopathic Clinical Education
