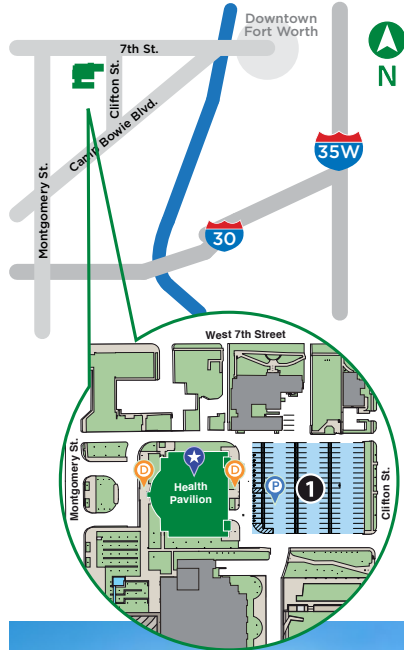

- Parking is located on the east side of building in Lot 1. Access from Montgomery and Clifton.

Take 7th Street West.
Turn Left (South) on Clifton Street.
Parking and patient drop off located immediately to your right (West).

From I-35W:

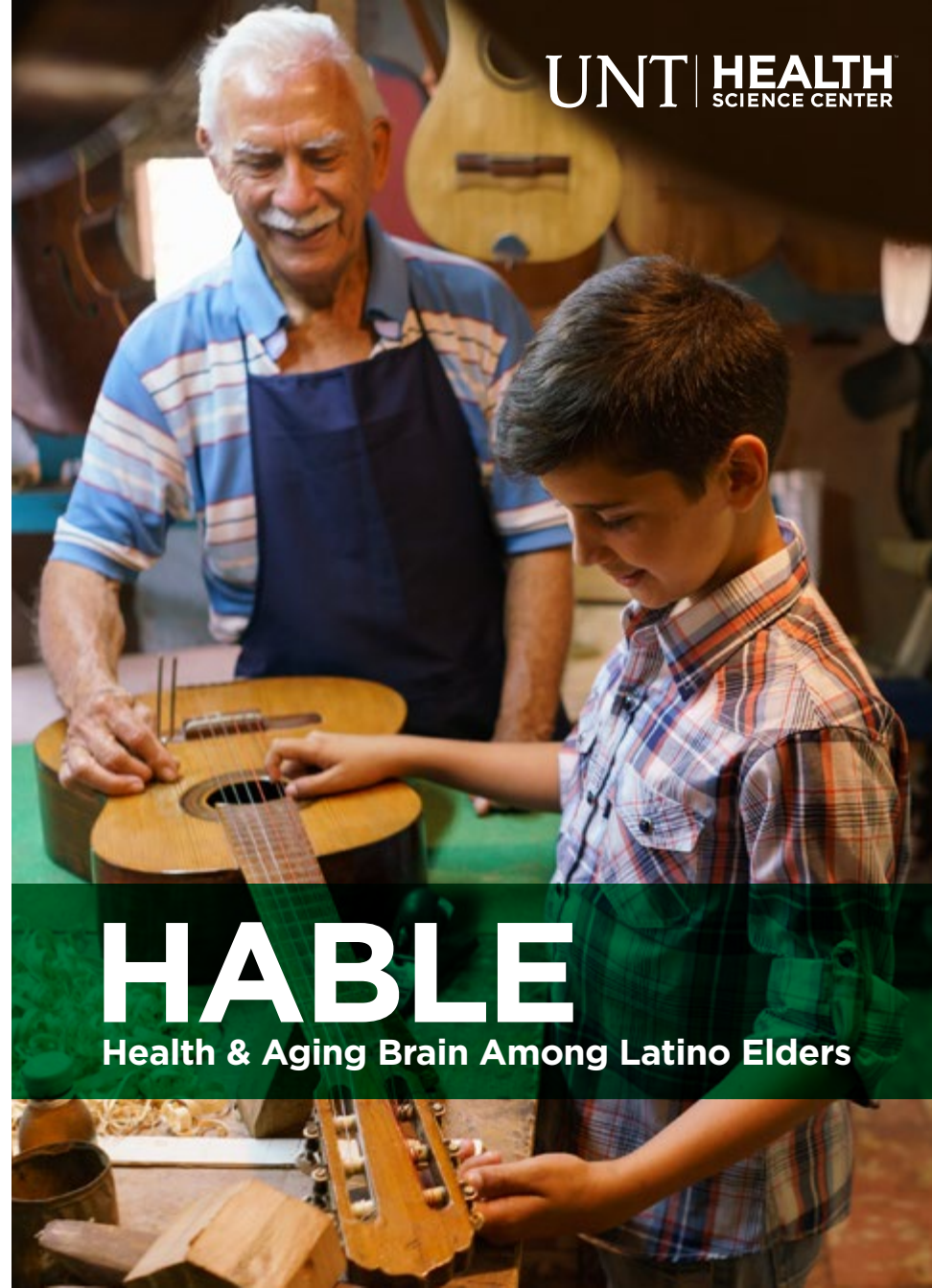
Take I-35 W to I-30 West toward Abilene (exit 51A).
Take Montgomery Street exit (exit 11).
Turn right (North) onto Montgomery Street.
Travel 1.2 miles and the Health Pavilion will be on your right (East).
Patient drop off in front circle drive.

Facts about aging in Mexican Americans

- Mexican Americans represent the fastest growing aging population in the country.
- 1 million Mexican Americans will be diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease by 2030.
- Alzheimer's Disease impacts Mexican Americans almost a decade earlier than other ethnic groups.
- The HABLE study, at UNTHSC, is one of the largest research studies of aging and Alzheimer's Disease in Mexican Americans in the United States. By studying normal aging and Alzheimer's in the Mexican culture we hope to create better interventions and treatment programs.

Health and Aging Brain Study

- We are looking for adults, 50 years or older, who are either Mexican American or of Mexican descent, to participate in a research study.
- As a research participant you will undergo memory tests, functional exam, interview, blood draw, and an MRI of the head at no cost.
- Participation is free and you will be compensated for your time. You can choose to have a copy of your results sent to you and your medical provider.
- You will be asked to repeat these procedures in 24 months.
- Assessments are done in English or Spanish.
