What department does Laura work for?	To find the building where Laura works...go to this building which was built in 1976. This was the first permanent building on campus.	Find the floor and office where Laura works and you will retrieve one of the key words to solving your final clue.
2	Did you know? Sandra Boyd was born and raised in California, then spent 14 years in Louisiana. Wow! Talk about a big change. Sandra is the Administrative Coordinator for a ground-breaking research institute that is creating innovative ways to test for and treat Alzheimer's.	What institute does Sandra work for?	To find the building where Sandra works...this newly renovated space was once Envision Imaging.	Find the lobby area which leads to where Sandra works and you will retrieve one of the key words to solving your final clue.
3	Skip the long lines at the corner pharmacy! Here you will find Dr. Farrah Shaikh hard at work assisting customers with their purchases of over-the-counter products such as allergy, cough and cold, digestive health, first aid, pain & fever, pediatric products, and vitamins.	What is the name of the location where Dr. Farrah Shaikh works?	To find the building where Dr. Shaikh works...which building has its own garage with connection to the Library?	Find the lobby area where Dr. Farrah Shaikh works and you will retrieve one of the key words to solving your final clue.
4	You may have seen him creating some cool stuff. Stephen McBroom is located in the building that has the most "stories" and his department is known for creating innovative learning experiences.	What department does Stephen work for?	To find the floor and building where Stephen is located...Shhhhhh! Keep quiet as you navigate through the studying students to visit his office.	Find the hallway where Stephen works and you will retrieve one of the key words to solving your final clue.
5	See it to believe it! This is where you will find Sherri Feris working hard with her team that focuses on solutions for eye diseases, such as glaucoma.	What institute does Sherri work for?	This building is the only location you can find fresh french fries and is the building where early voting recently took place.	Find the lab where Sherri works and you will find the poster in the hallway.
6	Alex Fernandez is helping people stay fit. In the building where he works, you can shoot hoops on the outdoor basketball court or pedal miles to nowhere on a stationary bike, all without leaving campus.	What is the name of the location where Alex works?	There is some heaving lifting going on in this location. :)	Find the building where Alex works and you will find the poster on the wall next to his office.
7	JC Killingsworth, a 2021 Valubility of the Year nominee, supports and serves alongside his comrades who protect HSC and patrols by foot, electric bike, and vehicle.	What department does JC work for?	You may have parked your car on top of this building.	Find the building where JC works and you will find the poster with your key word in the lobby.
8	You could say that Joshua Christian works with dummies. He works in a location where students and experienced healthcare providers acquire new skills to improve patient outcomes in a safe and simulated environment.	What Center does Joshua work for?	If you look outside this building you might see people playing flag football on its lawn.	Find the 1st floor lobby in the building where Joshua works and you will find a poster with your next keyword.
9	Kendel Rogers works in an office where you can find an ecosystem with pipelines that grow innovation and entrepreneurship.	What's the name of where Kendel works?	This six-story building is within walking distance. You might want to stop by 7-Eleven for a snack on your way over.	Find the office where Kendel works and you will find the poster in their lobby which contains your next keyword.
10	Claudia Yellott provides great sensitivity and care to donors. The program she works for provides a "Legacy of Life" ceremony.	What program does Claudia work for?	This building just recently had two large cooling towers added to its roof. You literally can't miss them if you look up. :)	Find the main lobby that leads to Claudia's office and you will find the poster which contains your next keyword.

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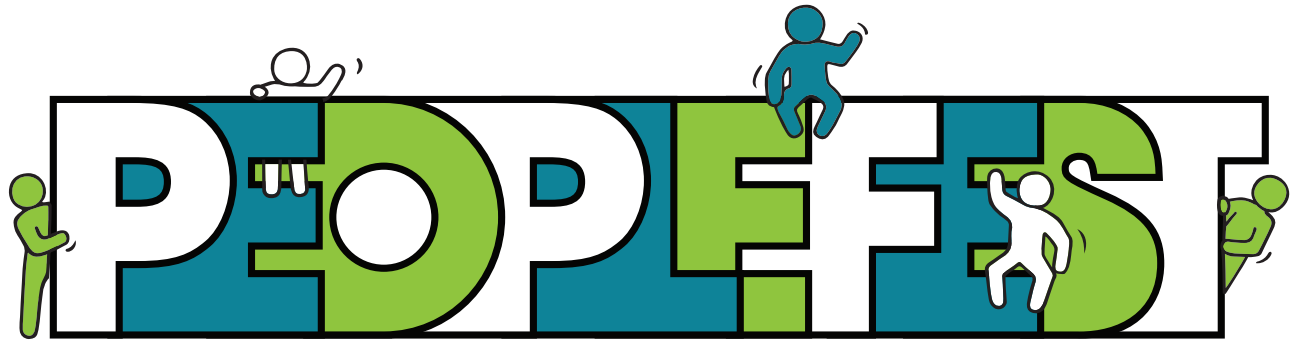


How to play

Look for a PeopleFest 2022 poster at each location that will contain the hidden key word critical to solving the final clue. Unscramble the words and solve the puzzle to claim your prize!

Instructions:

- On your game page, you will find your clues, questions and hints to find the buildings and "key word" location instructions.
- There are five steps to complete.
 1. Decipher the clue.
 2. Write the answer to the clue on your answer sheet.
(The answer to the clue will lead you to the designated area where the poster can be found).
 3. Follow the key word instructions on the game page to find the HSC Connection Exploration poster with the hidden key word.
 4. Reveal the hidden word under the flap on the poster.
 5. Fill in the key word on your answer sheet.
- Once you find all the locations and all the hidden key words put the key words together in the sentence at the bottom of your answer sheet page and that will lead you to your final destination.
- The game can be played at your own pace, which will give you time to read the information provided about each selected location and learn more about what goes on in those areas.
- You do not have to answer the clues in any particular order. Once you have answered all the clues, filled in all the key words and discovered the final destination, you will turn in your answer sheet with your name on it for a prize at the final destination.
- The game will begin on Friday, February 25th at 12pm and should be completed by 12pm on March 2nd.
